## Responsibilities

Key responsibilities of this role will include:

- Preparation of monthly trial balance reconciliation, including the maintenance of work papers with appropriate supporting documentation.
- Manage the AR/AP processes including payments and banking.
- Review and integrate fee data for Funds into accounting ledger.
- Preparation of month end reports.
- Providing variance and expense analysis.
- Preparation of year-end statutory financial statements on a single entity and consolidated level.
- Assisting with the year-end audit for the corporate entities.
- Prepare consolidated taxes returns (such as company tax, GST, and FBT).
- Assisting with the review of statutory financial statements, trust tax returns and quarterly BAS for the Funds.
- Maintain proper filing of documents.
- Communication with banks, outsource providers and vendors in order to deal with daily responsibilities.
- Collaborate with the wider business to streamline and improve the reporting processes and finance function.
